Timothy Myers assumed the role of President/CEO of Baptist Senior Family on January 2, 2022, following the retirement of Al Allison, Jr. at the end of 2021.

Tim was selected by the Baptist Senior Family Board of Directors following a national search performed by WittKieffer, a global executive search firm. Tim comes to Baptist Senior Family from Ingleside, the parent corporation of six senior service entities in the greater Washington, DC area that includes

three full-service Life Plan Communities and serves more than 1,100 residents.

Board Chair **Erin Stinner** commented, "Tim's exceptionally strong financial background and ability to lead excites us about entering the next frontier of Baptist Senior Family's commitment to caring for seniors in our Pittsburgh communities. His energy and expertise are the perfect fit for the opportunities that lie ahead."

Providence at Home and Providence Home Care are part of Baptist Senior Family and represent a different way of serving residents where they, and most of us, would like to live—independently in our home. As COVID (hopefully) becomes part of our shared history there will be more time spent on what’s next. All of us have a role in shaping Baptist Senior Family’s future and we will embrace that future together. is committed to continue strengthening Baptist Senior Family's reputation for outstanding person-centered care.

"The need to provide a quality environment and quality care continues to be paramount," **Myers** said. "Expectations among those we serve are changing. Their expectation of how we can bring services to them, of how those

services are delivered, and how they are paid for present a great opportunity for Baptist Senior Family. Everyone at Baptist Senior Family looks forward to continuing to serve our community."



New Gift Annuity Announced

As a token of her appreciation for the service she received as a skilled nursing resident at Baptist Homes, **Donna Miller** has established a \$27,300 gift annuity to benefit the Samaritan Fund for Resident Assistance.

Donna suffered a catastrophic leg injury during the COVID-19 pandemic. Following surgery, she chose Baptist Homes for rehabilitation.

"From those who assisted with my physical therapy, especially during COVID times dressed ready for combat, those who cooked and served my meals and cleaned my room, to the nurses and staff who visited daily to assure my needs were being met, I couldn't have had better care," said Donna.

"While nobody ever wants a catastrophic injury, if I had to fall, it was great to have a place like Baptist Homes to lift me up."

Jack and Donna Miller wanted to find a way to make a larger contribution to express

their gratitude to Baptist Homes, but not "break the bank." The gift annuity offered the perfect solution.

A gift annuity is a contract with a qualified charity that provides a donor with fixed income for life in exchange for a sizeable donation. In Donna's case, the annuity will provide her with \$1,200 per year for the rest of her life and Baptist Homes Foundation will receive a \$10,000 gift to the Samaritan Fund for Resident Assistance. Such gifts can be made

with cash, securities or other assets. In return, donors are eligible to take a partial tax deduction for their donation in addition to receiving lifetime income. Providence Point resident **Tibey Falk** established the first Baptist Homes Foundation gift annuity funded with appreciated securities (see *Along the Journey, Summer 2021*).

Jack said, "We were fortunate to have insurance to cover most costs related to Donna's fall, and wise enough to know that the quality of Baptist Homes' care would give Donna her best chance to return to normal. That's why we continue to support Baptist Senior Family and encourage others to do the same."



THE CYCLE OF LOVE

While Baptist Senior Family has always been committed to serving persons of all faith traditions, it would not exist today were it not for the foresight of the Baptist leaders who founded our organization to address the needs of widows and orphans in the area.

We were reminded of that relationship when Baptist Homes Foundation received notification of a *Petition of Distribution Before Dissolving*, pertaining to Mt. Lebanon Baptist Church.

Baptist Homes always had a close tie with this church. Reverend Bob Overstreet, who served as pastor from 1972 to 1984, remembers the generosity of his congregation in supporting Baptist Homes.

“Members not only supported Baptist Homes financially, but volunteered there. Some, like **Dave Berry**, even served as board members and Auxiliaries,” said Rev. Overstreet.

“It was difficult to see that church close, but comforting to know that its legacy

continues through Baptist Homes Society [now Baptist Senior Family].”

The connection with the former church goes even deeper. Providence Point residents, (and former board member) **Larry** and **Mardi Jackley**, purchased stained glass windows at an auction held at that church. The windows were originally commissioned in 1894 from Rudy Bros. & Reich for the First Baptist Church of Carnegie. The Jackleys donated the windows to the Baptist Homes Foundation for Providence Point’s new chapel. “Looking back, Mardi and I see God’s hand in this,” says Larry.

Perhaps David G. Rasch, Mt. Lebanon Baptist Church’s Chairman of Stewardship, Properties and Finance said it best in the letter that accompanied a check in the amount of \$9,245.71, the net proceeds from the sale of the church.

“As a final gesture of Christian love, the remaining members determined it was appropriate to make a contribution to the Samaritan Fund for Resident Assistance.”

This stimulation has been shown to enable people with dementia to be more alert and social, and to calm those who may be coping with anxiety.

This table was provided as a gift to Providence Point from a family who wishes to remain anonymous but asked that it be called "Bob's Magic Table" in his memory. It is the first Tovertafel system in Pennsylvania.


MVP OF THE YEAR ANNOUNCED



EAF breaks a record AGAIN!

It was another chart-busting year for the **2021 Employee Appreciation Fund (EAF)** campaign. Gifts from residents, family members and friends collectively topped **\$467,939!**

On December 3, 2021, every penny was distributed to approximately 500 grateful employees. Based on job classification (full/part-time/casual) and length of service, the gift amount for staff ranged from just over \$1,300 to about \$329.

Since Pennsylvania law prohibits employees from accepting gratuities, this campaign, created by **Baptist Senior Family's** Board of Directors, allows residents, families, friends and colleagues to monetarily recognize employees' exceptional service. Each year, Baptist Homes Foundation conducts

this campaign to show appreciation for all the employees who serve the residents at Baptist Homes and Providence Point. Through the EAF, all non-executive, non-contracted employees are eligible, and gifts to the EAF are tax-deductible to the full extent of the law.

Providence Point residents established an EAF committee several years ago and hold events to raise even more money for the fund.

In November, the EAF Committee at Providence Point, with the support of the



Baptist Homes Foundation, raffled off four baskets filled with unique items and gift cards. The winners were announced at the Holiday Arcade on November 18 where more than 20 vendors were on site selling a variety of holiday items. All proceeds from the raffle and arcade benefit the EAF.
